

CALL FOR ART

Application for the 2011 GEAG Art Exhibit at McKendree University, 701 College Road,
Lebanon, IL.

The Hettenhausen Performing Arts Center, known as the "Hett" is again hosting an exhibit of art by members of the Gateway East Artist Guild. This will be our fourth year for this highly successful exhibit. There is no charge to exhibit, but wall space is limited to about 25 pieces so applications will be accepted on a "first come" basis. (See the application form below). Also, the Hett's Board of Directors will have the final say on pieces selected for exhibit. Your Exhibits Committee will hang the art work and will install all necessary wall tags. They will also prepare hand-out sheets with prices and artist contact information for sales to be handled between the artist and buyer. All paintings and drawings must be framed and equipped with wires for hanging. If you are proposing 3D art that requires a support, you must provide your own pedestal at least 36" tall and professional in appearance. GEAG and the Hett will take all reasonable precautions, but the Hett lobby can become crowded at some performances and you must assume all risk for your own work.

RULES:

1. Exhibitors must be GEAG Members.
2. Size limits: Framed dimensions may not exceed 36" on any side.
3. The Application Form provided below must accompany your submittal.

Please submit applications to arrive in Marty's hands NLT **Monday, January 16**. The Hett's Board of Directors will complete their review by Friday, January 20.

4. Applications must be accompanied by a digital image or photo of the art work being submitted for Hett's consideration. Please size your digital photos to 600x800 pixels.
5. Artists will be notified of acceptance during the week of January 23.
6. Accepted pieces must be delivered to the Hett on Tuesday, January 31, between the hours of 5pm and 7 pm. Please make sure that your frames and mats are in exhibit condition. GEAG volunteers will hang the art work.
7. Your art work can be retrieved from the Hett on Monday, March 5, between the hours of 5pm and 7pm.
